Seneca Shares is a consortium of the five libraries in Seneca County. The libraries are linked electronically by a common automation system located at and supported by the Finger Lakes Library System in Ithaca. Although the libraries share an automation system, each library is governed by its own Board of Trustees and individual library policies.

Seneca County libraries share a common card, meaning that your Seneca Falls library card can be used at Interlaken, Lodi, Ovid, and Waterloo libraries. You'll also have access to all the new materials in Seneca County libraries, not just those at Seneca Falls.

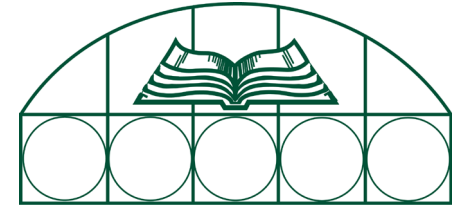
The mission of the Seneca Falls Library
